Interpretation

The granting of this waste facility permit, and any condition imposed by it, does not exempt the holder of the waste facility permit from complying with the statutory obligations of any relevant legislation, including water pollution, air pollution, waste, litter and planning legislation or legal liabilities under any other enactment or regulations whatsoever. The permit holder is legally responsible for all aspects of the operation and management of the permitted activity.

Introduction

This introduction is not part of the waste facility permit and does not purport to be a legal interpretation of the waste facility permit.

Waste cooking oils & fats are received to this site in various containers (20Ltr buckets, 120Ltr barrels, 240Ltr wheelie bins & bulk tanks on board Frylite vehicles). All wastes are collected by Frylite in Frylite owned and driven vehicles. Waste is weighed in on arrival on calibrated pallet scales and sorted according to containment and waste type. Waste is stored on pallets and within IBCs in a designated storage area located within the rear yard. All wastes are transferred by Frylite to Frylite Strabane for processing. The site is purely for the receipt and temporary storage of waste and no treatment is carried out on site
