### 1.3 Permitted wastes

#### *Permitted quantities of wastes*

- 1.3.1 The total quantity of waste accepted at the site per year shall not exceed 25,000 tonnes. The maximum storage capacities shall not exceed those detailed in the Working Plan unless agreed in writing with the Department.
